





HOLIDAY TRAVEL ASSISTANCE FOR MILITARY FAMILIES

The Armed Services YMCA, in partnership with Jack Daniels and American Airlines, brings troops home for the holidays with Operation Ride Home. Eligible service members and their families receive funding towards travel from their duty station to spend time with their loved ones back home.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Free or subsidized round-trip airfare.
- Participants determined and prioritized based on compelling reason and financial need.
- Participants must complete an application and upon award of travel, submit a video testimonial and thank you note.

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Active-Duty E1-E5. Dependents may complete the application only if their service member is actively deployed.
- Family members must travel with their service member unless he/she is actively deployed
- Open state-wide. Must be stationed in Hawaii.

Official Operation Ride Home Command Leave Approval Form must be signed, completed, and submitted as part the application.




Judd Trail Loop &


Jackass Ginger Pool

(1.21 mile loop trail near Honolulu) **Address:** 4022 Nuuanu Pali Dr, Honolulu, HI 96817

This is one of the easiest places to see a waterfall on Oahu, even if it's not as large as others!
